## Frequently Asked Questions:

*Will you mail me a registration packet?*  
No. When you arrive at the park, stop by our registration table and we'll provide you with your raffle and contest tickets, nail trim and/or microchip vouchers.

*My other dog is not a greyhound; can I bring him/her?* Unfortunately, no. We love dogs of all breeds, but this is a greyhound only event.

*How many greyhounds can I bring?* In order to keep all participating dogs under control, please adhere to a 3 greyhounds per adult limit. Please note: ALL greyhounds to be leashed at all times, unless crated or in an X-pen. No Flexi or retractable leashes, please.

*Do I have to pick up after my dog?* Yes, please! Pickup bags will be provided. We want everyone to enjoy the event and we'd like to be invited back next year. Thank you!

*I registered but I can't make it; can I get a refund?* Unfortunately, we cannot offer refunds, however, if you purchased a nail trim or microchip, we will mail you a voucher to be used at future clinics.

**Directions to Cabin John Park:**

From the Capitol Beltway (I-495), take Exit 41 (Clara Barton Parkway). If you're coming from Maryland, this is the last exit before you hit the American Legion Bridge spanning the Potomac River; if you're coming from Virginia, it's the first exit in Maryland. Once on Clara Barton Pkwy, take the exit for Carderock/Carderock Division Nav SurWarCen. At the top of the exit ramp, go left, crossing over the Parkway, then continue straight into Carderock Park. At the T-intersection, go left and continue to the parking lot. You'll see the pavilion on your right.
